All puppies sold by Taboo English Bulldogs have been examined by a veterinarian prior to sale and are guaranteed to be sound and in good health at this time.

They will come having their first set of shots and deworming. However a complete scheduled series of (4) inoculations are recommended. (4 separate injections in a series of 4), and it will be necessary for the purchaser to complete the scheduled series of inoculations on time and by a licensed veterinarian in order to protect the puppy and for its health guarantee to remain valid. Most vets agree weeks 6-7, 9-10, 12-13, and 15-16 weeks. its ok to go 3 to 4 weeks in between shots.

Taboo English Bulldogs certifies that at the time of the sale and to the best of our knowledge the puppy is free of any illness or life threatening congenital birth defects. The congenital hereditary health guarantee does not cover; demodect mange, cherry eye, entropion, loose hips, skin allergies, giardia, coccidian, internal parasites, bacterial or viral infections, elongated soft palate and nasal snares.

The buyer is advised to have the puppy examined by a licensed vet of the buyers choice within 2 working days to assure them that they have purchased a healthy puppy. This will be done at the purchasers expense. Under no circumstances will Taboo English Bulldogs be responsible for any vet bills aquired by the purchaser of this puppy. Minor, breed related, treatable or correctable conditions, or any condition that may go away or is considered a condition which a puppy will likely out grow, are not covered. Failure to have puppy examined by said time will void this contract.

Taboo English Bulldogs will , on conformation of a life threatening genetic condition, found within 48 hours(2 working days of purchase), give buyer a replacement puppy of equal value from current or upcoming litters.

Furthermore, extending the guarantee to 12 months, certain health issues as follows; limited to leukemia, heart malformation, heart murmur and pulmonary stenosis. If one of these arise within the first 12 months of purchase, and a licensed vet believes could be life threatening genetic related, then buyer to notify seller within 48 hours with;

1. A written explanation from a licensed vet and backed up by lab work or x-rays showing the nature of the problem. In a case of death, a necropsy report will be necessary to determine the cause of death.
2. The seller will obtain a second opinion from a vet to whom Taboo English Bulldogs will choose.

Then buyer must;

3. Return the puppy and akc papers to the seller within 72 hours at buyers expense. If you are unwilling to release the puppy and akc papers into my possession, no replacement puppy will be offered, nor will i be part of the recovery process.
4. Proof that the puppy was examined by a vet no later than 2 working days from purchasing the puppy, and received further vet care and the complete series of shots also must accompany puppy when returned.

If the vets prognosis is that the puppy has a life threatening genetic disease as above and all the criteria are met, we will replace a puppy of equal value or apply the amount of your purchase price to a pup available now or in the future. Differant quality and color of pups determine price of pups. It is possible that pups available immediately will be a higher price.

If at any time you transfer ownership of the puppy or breed this dog under one year of age, this agreement is void immediately.

Taboo English Bulldogs is not responsible for the health of this puppy after the 48 hour period, except for the above 12 month coverage extension of the certain conditions mentioned.

Taboo English Bulldogs cannot guarantee that any male puppy sold will have two testicles. Sometimes it is weeks or a few months before both will drop or not at all. Nor do we guarantee a female can produce pups.

We will grant all puppies with akc full registration unless otherwise specified. All my pups will go to pet or small breeder homes and must never end up in a puppy mill.

In the event the buyer needs to rehome the puppy/dog the seller must be notified and get first right of refusal. It is understood that this puppy/dog must never be turned

over to a shelter.
